East passed and South opened 1H and made a fine decision of bidding 3S over a cue bid of 3D by North, which allowed North to wheel out RKCB and after finding they held all the key-cards investigated on the Kings. On finding 1 King North was able to bid the grand slam in clubs for a fine score of 97%!
